Top 10 Ways to Save at Walgreens

As your one-stop destination for everyday essentials, Walgreens ensures you receive the best prices. Here at BeFrugal.com, we've compiled a guide filled with expert tips on how to save even more at Walgreens.

1. Where to find Walgreens Coupons

Each week, Walgreens will publish coupons and promotional codes ranging from 5% to 30% off online and in-store purchases. For the latest Walgreens coupons and deals, check out [BeFrugal.com](#). You can also find more coupons online at Walgreens.com in their [coupons](#) section.

[Facebook](#) and [Twitter](#) can be another great resource to finding Walgreens deals and coupons. You don't need a Facebook or Twitter account to view their account pages. On the Walgreen's Facebook page, you can now view their interactive weekly ad on the Walgreens Facebook page.

The greatest thing about [Walgreens's coupon policy](#) is they allow coupon stacking. Walgreens allows 1 store coupon and 1 manufacturer coupon per item. You can also stack these with Register Rewards towards your final purchase amount. However, the number of coupons used per transaction cannot exceed the number of items you have. But there is no restriction on going through the cashier a second time to split up the number of items and coupons.

2. Check Your Receipt for Register Rewards

Walgreens doesn't offer a rewards card, but they do offer a [Register Rewards](#) Program (RRs). For in-store purchases, when you buy qualifying items, at the bottom of your receipt there will be RRs worth \$1 to \$10 that can be used towards your next purchase. However there are limitations – if you purchase more than one of the same item that are eligible for RRs, you will only receive 1 RRs coupon. To get RRs for each of the same item, you will have to make separate transactions. You can ask a sales associate for more info on Register Rewards.

3. Find Walgreens Weekly Ad

Grab your Walgreens weekly ad flyer and coupon booklet in the front of the store at all locations or online at [Walgreens.com](#). You can also find the weekly ad flyer in your local Sunday Newspaper. The weekly ad flyer and coupon booklet will include the best deals for the week at Walgreens and which products are eligible for Register Rewards.

4. Sign up for Email Alerts

To receive exclusive coupons and deals right to your inbox, enroll in Walgreens [email subscriptions](#). You can select to receive a variety of e-newsletters on Special Deals & Savings, Photo News & Offers, Health & Pharmacy, Weekly Ad Sneak Peek, and Diabetes.

5. The Walgreens Card

To help lower healthcare costs on prescriptions and other health items at Walgreens, we recommend applying for the [Walgreens Card](#). This card is a platform card that can carry multiple Walgreens programs that save you money, such as: Walgreens Prescription Savings Club, Walgreens Wellness Benefit and Walgreens Bonuses.

The [Walgreens Prescription Savings Club](#) can help patients with no prescription drug coverage save on medications for the whole family, including pets. A small membership fee does apply for this program but can save you hundreds yearly on your prescriptions.

The [Walgreens Wellness Benefit](#) program offers funding on your Walgreens Card by your employer or healthcare provider to help pay for eligible health items, such as: First aid supplies, blood pressure monitors, vitamins, reading classes and much more.

With the [Walgreens Bonuses](#) program, you'll earn bonuses on all Walgreens brand item purchases. Bonuses earned will be applied to future purchase totals. You can view your bonus earnings and redemptions on your receipt after each transaction (there are exclusions on certain products)

6. Ask for a Rain Check

If Walgreens is out of stock on a sale item that you intended to buy, ask your sales associate for a rain check. Once that item is back in stock, you can use your rain check to purchase that item for the sales price. Rain checks are only valid for 30 days.

7. Shop Online with Free Shipping

It's always more convenient to shop online but who wants to pay for shipping? On walgreens.com, if your order is over \$25 you'll receive [free standard shipping](#) on thousands of items. Look for the "Ships for Free" tag next to eligible items.

8. Earn Cash Back on Your Online Order

Earning cash back on all your Walgreens.com orders is easy and free, plus you can stack this on top of promotional codes for extra savings! Sign up as a [BeFrugal.com cash back member](#) and you'll receive cash back on all your Walgreens online purchases.

9. Buy Discounted Walgreens Gift Cards

You should never pay full price for Gift Cards to Walgreens! Either for gift ideas or just for yourself, you can purchase discounted gift cards for up to 25% off their retail value. The best places to find Walgreens discounted gift cards would be to search [ebay.com](#) or use a [discounted gift card finder](#).

10. Become a Walgreens Employee

The most exciting reward to working in retail is the [employee discount](#)! Walgreens employees and their immediate families receive a 15% discount on most items and a 20% discount on Walgreens and W brand products. Employees can also stack on other discounts, coupons, Register Rewards that are available to the public on top of their employee discount.

A Few Other Things You Should Know

After all this shopping and saving, if in the unfortunate event you are unhappy with your recent Walgreens purchase there are a few things you should know:

1. **Call Customer Service:** The first place to start addressing your concerns is directly with a Walgreens representative. You can either head into a store to speak

with a manager or sales associate or [contact](#) Walgreens customer service department.

2. **Walgreens Return Policy:** CVS has a hassle-free [return policy](#). Bring back any product, opened, unopened, or defective, along with your receipt within 30 days for a full refund (Some exceptions may apply on certain products). For online orders at [walgreens.com](#), you may return your item in-store or fill out a UPS Returns form online to ship your order back to [Walgreens.com](#)
